

Information Sheet

- Medications are set up in strip packaging, divided by dose, times, and days
- Medication boxes are mailed or delivered every 28 days depending on location
- Refills are coordinated between all patient care providers through the pharmacy
- Medication information is included on each package, including name, color of pill, dose
- A comprehensive medication review conducted by the pharmacist and a phone consultation with the member increases personal accountability
- The box would follow the child eliminating extra pharmacy visits
- Reminders can be sent by telephone call or text before each dose
- Both the service and delivery are free to the patient
- The program is individualized for each patient
- Boxes will be delivered to residences, residential facilities, group homes
- School boxes are available
- Two weeks before each box is delivered a pharmacy team member will contact the member to review medications and answer questions, providing additional value and support often not found with traditional pharmacies
- Non-packaged medications are included to improve adherence
- The program creates a collaborative working relationship between client, physician and pharmacist

2014 study conducted by Golden Plains showed medication adherence improved to *97.3% with use of the Med Manager program.

*National average is 70-75%

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
