




### SHAME (STIGMA)

# Don't be an accidental dealer!



In 2016, enough opioids were prescribed in Oklahoma for every adult to have more than 100 pills. Oklahoma had the sixth highest opioid prescribing rate in the nation in 2016. We must continue to address prescribing practices. We must bring the accidental overdose death rate

## E EDUCATE

Schools, communities, and individuals must understand the dangers of opioid abuse. Store, use, and dispose of opioids appropriately. Teach people not to be 'Accidental Dealers'. Please spread the information that you have heard here today. This can happen to anyone.



## NOW

There has been progress made in the past 6 years primarily through the efforts of the Oklahoma Department of Mental Heath and Substance Abuse. Our legislature has also passed important legislation. However, it is not enough! In 2017 (NIDA) reported 388 overdose deaths involving Oklahomans. We lead the nation in non-medical use of prescription pain medications. We must stop this epidemic for future generations. The future is in your hands.
